Final Instructions

Thank you for your entry for our March Autotest; we hope you enjoy the day's competition. We also thank the management at Trac Môn for the use of the excellent facilities at one of the top UK race circuits and all the marshals for giving their time to assist us.

AMENDMENTS TO THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

5. CHAMPIONSHIPS

The event is a round of the ANWCC Autotest Championship (MSA Permit 61/2018) and relevant championships, including the ANWCC All-rounders Championship (MSA Permit 45/2018), the Glynne Edwards Memorial Championship 2018 (MSA Permit 59/2018) and relevant C&A MC club championships.

The National B Autotest is also a round of the WAMC Autotest Championship (MSA Permit 89/2018).

13. AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the event to the overall and class winners. Second and third in class awards may be presented subject to three and eight entries respectively in the class.

An award will be presented to the highest placed lady driver in each event, i.e., National B Autotest, Clubman Autotest and Clubman PCA, subject to there being three qualifying competitors in that event.

DIRECTIONS

For Trac Môn (Anglesey Circuit):

The postcode for the venue is LL63 5TF. Leave the A55 dual carriageway at junction 5; there is a brown tourism sign for the circuit. Follow the A4080 signposted Rhosneigr and Aberffraw and after almost five miles turn right at a small crossroads – signposted with a brown tourism sign.

PROCEDURE

On arrival please first report to signing-on downstairs in the Tower Block which opens at 08:30 hours. Remember your **membership cards** and any outstanding payments. National B competitors will also need to produce appropriate **MSA Competition Licence** and **championship registration cards**.

After signing-on, unload and park trailers in the large paddock area.

Proceed to scrutineering in the garage nearest the Tower Block, where you will be issued with your competition number.

TIMETABLE

Signing-on and Scrutineering open **08:30 hours**.

Signing-on and Scrutineering close **10.00 hours**.

Any competitor not signed-on by **10:00 hours** may be classed as a non-starter.

There will be a drivers' briefing at **10:15 hours**, after signing-on and in the scrutineering garage..

First car starts at approximately **10:30 hours**.

There will be a lunch break after three runs. The finish is expected to be at approximately **16:00 hours**.

TESTS

Test diagrams are available at www.camconline.co.uk on the March Autotest & PCA page under Forthcoming Events.

All the Tests will be open for "Walking" until the first car starts that test. There will also be a brief allowance to walk each test as a group.

The Clubman and National B events will have the same test diagrams.

The Entry list has been split into six groups. The first three Groups (A,B & C) are Clubmen and will do each Test A, B & C before lunch (Do NOT go to D,E & F until the afternoon).

The National B three Groups (D,E & F) do each Test Site D, E & F in the morning.

Group A will start on Site A, Group B on Site B, etc., and each car should run in numerical order within group. Each car will have 3 attempts at each Test before moving on as a group to the next Test Site.

Each competitor will have a Time Card specific to them and the Tests should be visited in the order on that Time Card.

If you encounter problems such as mechanical gremlins, please inform the Clerk of the Course. We will try to accommodate any drivers encountering issues, provided they do not acquire an advantage with road position due to weather, etc.

Running Results throughout the day will be posted on the Official Notice Board in the signing-on room.

Please check the Notice Board at the lunch interval to see how many tests will be run in the afternoon. We have a large entry so may have to reduce the number of runs if there are delays. Your prompt starting of tests will dictate if we are able to run all 18 tests.

FACILITIES

Toilets and refreshments will be available on site.

Please note there are no petrol stations or convenience stores near the venue. The closest are in Gaerwen, just off junction 7 of the A55 at LL60 6HL.

REMINDERS.

PRACTICING

Practicing anywhere in or near the venue is prohibited under pain of exclusion. This will include speeding, handbrake turns, skidding, wheel spinning and aggressive driving whilst not on tests.

DAMAGE

Any competitor experiencing a puncture / deflated tyre on the track must stop immediately.

If a competitor causes third party damage during the event they may be liable to the repair costs up to the value of the insurance excess (currently £500).
