Supplementary Regulations

- 1. The Caernarvonshire & Anglesey Motor Club Ltd will organise a Gymkhana on Sunday, 3rd June, at Sherry Farm, Llandrygan, Llanerch-y-medd, LL71 7AN.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. A MSA Certificate of Exemption, Permit number 107655, has been issued and will be displayed on the day.

4. Eligibility

The event is open to members of

- Bala & DMC
- Caernarvonshire & Anglesey MC
- Clwyd Vale MC
- Harlech & DMC
- Knutsford & DMC
- North Wales CC
- 116 MC
- Rhyl & DMC

All competitors <u>must</u> produce a valid Club Membership card, which will be inspected at signing on.

MSA licences are not required.

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are aged 14 years and over who do not have a valid, full RTA Licence, subject to:

- a) The vehicle must by definition be a "Touring Car";
- b) The vehicle engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc, including forced induction;
- c) A passenger must be carried who holds a valid, full RTA licence and
- who must produce a valid Club Membership Card.

Passengers must be aged 12 years or over and be at least 135cm in height.

Any drivers who do not hold a full drivers' licence can only drive on site whilst accompanied by a responsible adult holding a full RTA licence.

5. Signing-on and Scrutineering

Signing-on and scrutineering opens 09:00 hours.

Signing-on and scrutineering closes 10.30 hours.

Any competitor not signed-on by 10:30 may be classed as a non-starter.

Drivers may not swap cars or passengers after signing-on under any circumstances.

There will be a drivers' briefing at 10:35 after signing-on. First car starts at approximately 10:45 hours The finish is expected to be approximately 17:00 hours

6. Information

• Refreshments

Catering will be provided by Sion Môn's butty van and will be on site all day.

• Toilets

Toilet facilities will be provided.

7. Entries open on publication of these SR's and close on 3rd June 2018 at 10.30 hours.

The maximum number of entries for the entire meeting is **50**. The minimum is 10. Entries will be accepted at the organisers' discretion, using a first come, first served basis. The entry fee is $\underline{25}$, or a reduced entry fee of $\underline{20}$ for each driver under 18 years of age on the day of the event.

8. Classes

The Gymkhana will consist of 3 classes as follows:

- A. Male
- B. Female
- C. Junior (under 18 years old)

Competitors are reminded of the following:

- All cars <u>must</u> be fitted with a rear towing eye.
- Competing cars do not need MOT or TAX.
- Seat belts <u>must</u> be worn.
- Passenger window <u>must</u> be closed.
- Cars must have the original bumpers and lamps at the front and rear.
- Open or Sports cars can only compete with their hoods erected or a hard top fitted.
- Tyres must have a minimum tread depth of 1.6 mm at the start of the event.
- Cars must **not be fitted with tyres in list 1B** of the MSA blue book. (the most common list 1B tyre used locally is probably the **Yokohama 21R**).
- All Cars must comply with MSA tyre and vehicle regulations.
- 9. Officials:

All marshals are Judges of Fact with regard to test penalties, and their decision will be final. A list will be available for examination at the event.

10. Awards will be presented to the winner of each game.

- 11. Results will be calculated by the organisers in a manner appropriate to the status of the event and provisional results will be published on the official notice board at the venue as soon as possible. Final results will be posted on the club website <u>www.camconline.co.uk</u> This is a fun event that is not to be taken too seriously. Protests are not considered to be in the spirit of the event.
- 12. Details of all tests will be available on the day at signing-on.
- 13. Marking and penalties will be:

PENALTIES

(a) Not attempting a test, or failing to attempt a test when instructed to do so

	Maximum.
(b) Wrong test	Maximum.
(c) Striking a pylon or cone	5 seconds
(d) Failing to cross/stop at a penalty line	5 seconds
(e) Striking a boundary structure (fence, tree, pallets, e	tc.)5 seconds.
EXCLUSION	
(f) Abusive language or behavior	First offence - 10 seconds. Second offence - Disqualification.
(g) Driving in a manner deemed unsafe by the CoC	First offence - 10 seconds.

Second offence - Disqualification.

(h) Aggressive driving (hand-braking/speeding, etc.) whilst not on a test ...

First offence - 10 seconds. Second offence – Disqualification.

- 14. Practicing anywhere in or near the venue is prohibited under pain of exclusion. This will include speeding, handbrake turns, skidding, wheel spinning and aggressive driving whilst not on tests.
- 15. Competitors will be supplied with a competition number, which must be displayed clearly. If there is an insufficient number of marshals, competitors may be split into groups. One group will compete while another marshals, and so on.
- 16. All other GRs of the MSA apply as written except for the following which are amended:
 F10.2.1 A vehicle may be entered twice by different drivers for the same award, but no driver may drive more than one car.
 F4.3.2 Pylons may be less than 1m in height.
