PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGE OF VENUE.

We would like to extend our sincere thanks to the staff at Trac Môn for allowing us the use of the venue at short notice; we are very grateful for their invaluable support and assistance.

Once onto Anglesey, exit the A55 at Junction 5 and follow brown chequered flag signs for Race Circuit. Please note there are no local petrol or convenience stores near the venue. The closest is in Gaerwen, just off junction 7 of the A55 (LL60 6HL).

Toilets and refreshments are available at the venue.

PROCEDURE – see plan below.

Access the Circuit through the Main Gate, then take the first right, along the Spectator Access Road, towards the Medical Centre and Circuit Office.

On arrival please first report to signing-on at the Circuit Office, which **opens at 08:30 hours**.

For those who have not yet sent a fully completed entry form to the Entries Secretary, signing-on **CLOSES at 09:30 hours**.

For those who have already sent a fully completed entry form to the Entries Secretary, signing-on **CLOSES at 10:00 hours**.

Entry forms and membership forms will be available at the desk.

Please remember your club membership cards and any outstanding payments. National B competitors will also need to produce your Competition Licence and Championship Registration Cards.

After signing-on, unload and park trailers on the Spectator Access Road as marked on the plan. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.**

Once ready, please report to scrutineering, which **CLOSES at 10.00 hours**. This is at the location marked on the plan. Main things are battery and seat security, brakes and steering.

Competition numbers will be distributed at scrutineering, then park as directed by marshals.

All the tests will be open for “walking” until the first car starts that test. There will also be a brief allowance to walk each test as a group.

There will be a short drivers’ briefing at **10:15 hours** at the Circuit Office.

The first competitor will start immediately after, at approximately 10:30 hours.

The Clubman and National B events will have the same test diagrams.

All other awards remain as listed in the Supplementary Regulations.
