9. Classes

13. Scrutineering

Timetable for scrutineering will be as per Section 7 of the Additions and Amendments to the SR's.

Competitors are required to present their vehicle and their equipment along with the competition logbook/passport to scrutineering between the hours stated in the table above. Cars must be presented to scrutineering with door numbers in place. Any detachable lighting system (lamp pods etc.), which will be used on Saturday night must be fixed to the car and be in working order. If an onboard camera is being used, the camera and its mount must be presented to scrutineering attached to the car as it will be for the stages.

Competitors will be required to show the scrutineers their overalls, helmet and HANS device.

STAGE PROCEDURE FOR JUNIOR RALLY – REMINDER

This year's Pentraeth Glyn Memorial Stages is also a round of the Junior F1000 Rally Championship & Junior Ecosse Rally Challenge as defined by the championship rules. As part of the Motorsport UK requirements/regulations for this championship, competitors in the championship must run on stages by themselves, i.e. there must not be any of the competitors from the main events on the stage at the same time as the Juniors. To achieve this there will be a gap between the main event and the Juniors which will therefore stretch the running of all the days stages to the limit. In order to achieve this, cars in the Junior event will be interposed from the first running of the stage straight back into the second running of the stage, and road timing between stages will be operating. Just as road timing will be operating in the main event.

Saturday

Main event will run first on the road.

As soon as all cars from the main event have completed the pair of stages, or maximum lateness of the last car in the main event has been reached, the Junior Rally will be started. At that point no cars from the main event will be allowed to move on the stage until the Juniors have finished their two runs through. If a car has stopped on stage for any reason and the Juniors have started, THEY MUST NOT MOVE UNTIL THE JUNIORS HAVE FINISHED THEIR TWO RUNS THROUGH THE STAGE. (Junior runners will be denoted by running numbers 101 upwards). **Penalty is disgualification**.

After the Juniors have finished, any outstanding cars from the main field must not return to the paddock until permission has been granted via a radio marshal.

Sunday

Juniors will run first on the road.

As soon as all cars from the Junior event have completed the pair of stages, or maximum lateness of the last car in the Junior event has been reached, the Main Rally will be started. At that point no cars from the Junior event will be allowed to move on the stage until all cars in the main event have finished their two runs through. If a car has stopped on stage for any reason and the main event has started, THEY MUST NOT MOVE UNTIL THE MAIN EVENT COMPETITORS HAVE FINISHED THEIR TWO RUNS THROUGH THE STAGE. **Penalty is disgualification.**

After the main field have finished, any outstanding cars from the Juniors must not return to the paddock until permission has been granted via a radio marshal.

OTHER MATTERS

Please also note the following:-

- Road Rally Class Tyres as per Blue Book.
- Identification The organisers will supply hi-viz numbers for affixing to your rear side windows. Door numbers will be available for sale from Rally Office from 15:00hrs onwards on Friday, 24th November. Our sponsor's decals will be available at Environmental Scrutineering (Noise Test) on Saturday morning and must be affixed, one on each of your front door panels.
- Re-seeding of event Competitors from the main field will be reseeded overnight and will start Leg 2 in their reseeded order. Junior competitors WILL NOT be reseeded overnight and will re-start Leg 2 in their numerical order
- Lights and reflective jackets for service crew A proportion of day one will be held in the dark. Please give due consideration to the Health and Safety of your service crew. We strongly advise that you bring good quality torches or lights with you to aid your crew and that they wear high visibility clothing for the duration of the night stages.
- Food at the venue on Saturday night The circuit's bar will serve food up until 21:00hrs on Saturday night and will be serving a basic menu. There is no service time given at the end of day one therefore can you please make your way as soon as possible after the end of the last stage on Saturday to the café if you require food.
- Cycling Will not be permitted in the service area. If you wish to cycle the track, this is
 permitted before 09:00am on Saturday only. All cyclists on track MUST wear high visibility
 clothing and be aware that organisers and marshals vehicles will be on track
- Accidents If a crew are involved in an accident both members MUST report to the Chief Medical Officer for examination Immediately, if they intend to continue or Not.
- Dogs are strictly not allowed within the venue
