Caernarvonshire & Anglesey Motor Club Limited Club Championship Regulations

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for Club Championship points, an individual must be a fully paid up member of the Caernarvonshire & Anglesey Motor Club Limited (C&AMC).

QUALIFYING EVENTS

Qualifying events will be specified for each individual award.

CHAMPIONSHIP TERM

The Championships will run annually from 1st January to 31st December, with the exception of C&AMC organised events between 25th December and 31st December the previous year, which will count for both year's championships.

CLAIMING POINTS

Points cannot be awarded retrospectively for events where the individual was not a member at that time.

- Points will be awarded automatically for all C&AMC organised events.
- For all other events, members must submit their results via the electronic form on the C&A Motor Club website within 30 days of the event.
- The Championship Coordinator reserves the right to request proof of results from members.

Wherever possible the Championship Coordinator will aim to provide interim results updates periodically during the championship term.

Interim results shall remain provisional at all times. Final results shall be published no later than the 31st of January.

SCORING

Points scoring will be as follows:

All Attendance based championships (Don Mills Patron's Cup & Marshals Cup):

• 1 point awarded per event for attendance at any C&AMC organised event.

All competitive championships (Rally / Autotest / PCA / Trials):

- 1st overall: 20pts
- 2nd overall: 18pts
- 3rd overall: 15pts
 - o Overall points scorers above will not be eligible for class points.
- 1st in Class: 10 pts; 2nd in Class: 9 points, down to 8th in class: 3 points.
- All other class finishers score 2 points.
- Non-finishers score 1 point.
- If an event amalgamates classes, then the amalgamated class structure shall be used to score points.
- Dual permit events shall be scored separately as individual events.
- Named officials on a C&AMC organised event shall be awarded 15 points, in the discipline of the event (maximum of 2 claims per discipline).
- Signed-on marshals on a C&AMC organised event shall be awarded 10 points, in the discipline of the event (maximum of 2 claims per discipline).
- Exceptionally, for Navigation Runs:
 - o 1st overall: 12pts, through to 12th overall: 1pt
 - o Organisers shall score 10pts per event organised (maximum of 2 claims).

DISCIPLINES

For the purposes of the competitive championships, the disciplines are recognised as per below table and are consistent with individual discipline based awards:

- Note: for each discipline the definition of Novice Competitor is shown
- To qualify for the **All-Rounders** awards, a contender must have scored points in a minimum of three disciplines.
