FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry to the C&A Motor Club's Cefni Garage Targa Rally.

Your competitor number will be as per the published seeded entry list – which will follow once all competitors have complied with the entry requirements.

These Final Instructions contain important information that updates or supersedes the Supplementary Regulations, or act as reminders. Importantly, note the changes to the **timetable and tyre regulations as per Bulletin 1**.

CLARIFICATIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

6. PROGRAMME

Noise Check and Scrutineering will take place between 06:00 hours and 08:30 hours.

Any competitor not completed the 'drive thru' Competitor Pack collection by 08:45 hours may be refused a start and their place offered to a reserve crew. If your marshal fails to sign on, you may be asked to return your pack prior to MC0 and will not be able to start the Targa.

There will be a drivers' briefing at 08:55 hours (outside the Control Tower) and all competitors MUST attend.

Car 0 will start at MC0 at 09:30 hours (for individual start times please add your car number to this time).

Car 0 is due at the finish at approximately 15:45 hours.

23. Awards

Based on the number of competitors entered in various classes, awards will now be as follows:

1st Overall: Awards to Driver & Navigator

Class 1 Interclub Experts: Awards to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in class

Class 2 Interclub Semi-Experts: Awards to 1st & 2nd in class

Class 3 Interclub Novice: Awards to 1st & 2nd in class

Class 4 Clubman Experts: Awards to 1st in class

Class 5 Clubman Semi-Experts: Awards to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in class

Class 6 Novice: Awards to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in class

Best 1400 c.c.: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity

Under 21: Awards placed to highest placed Driver and Navigator aged 21 years or younger on the day of the event (not necessarily the same crew members)

Competitors will be awarded only one of the above awards unless no other eligible crew completes the event. Awards will be presented to both Driver and Navigator.

ARRIVAL, SCRUTINEERING & SIGNING-ON

Overnight Camping

Overnight camping is available at Trac Môn/Anglesey Circuit, please do not pitch your caravan in the designated trailer parking or competitors' holding area. Electricity hook up is available and the café will be open for a period during Saturday evening.

Trailer Park

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map. Please note that this area is denoted as a prohibited area for competitors for the duration of the event once Car 1 has left MC0. Any competitor entering this area during the event will be deemed as retired.

Fuel

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event, refuelling during the event is not permitted.

Fuel is NOT available at Trac Môn.

Illegal Servicing

See Supplementary Regulation 19 - Servicing will not be permitted at any time during the event, except by crews working on their own vehicles, or by fellow competitors. The penalty for infringement is disqualification. All competing vehicles will be parked in the designated holding area between test turnarounds (see plan on page 7); this area will be deemed a Control Area.

Marshals' Signing-on

Signing-on will be clearly labled at the Tower Building. **Each marshal MUST supply their own Hi-Viz, which must be always worn when marshalling on track.**

Competitors' Signing-on

Competitors signing on will need to be done electronically prior to the event. Handing out of competitor packs will be a 'drive thru' process following completion of process card.

Special Tests

Signed-on competitors will be permitted to walk the tests up to 08:45 hours, prior to the drivers' briefing.

Drivers' Briefing

A drivers' briefing will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 08:55 hours and all competitors **MUST** attend this briefing.
