
Please see the plan below for location of the trailer park, noise test and scrutineering.

A reminder that both members of your crew need to comply with certain important requirements.

- SIGNING-ON Online signing-on closes at 21:00 Saturday 20th January. You need to have uploaded a clear photo of your valid 2024 RS Interclub (minimum grade) Motorsport UK competition licence and club membership card.
 If you have not received your competition licence from Motorsport UK, we will need sight of the acknowledgement of your application.
 If you are applying on the night you need to bring a fully completed Motorsport UK RS Interclub licence application form, including payment details, ID photo and an UN-SEALED addressed and stamped envelope. You must also upload a photo of this form instead of your licence on your online entry form.
- CLUB MEMBERSHIP You upload a copy of your club membership card for an eligible club onto the online system. If you need to apply for membership for C&A Motor Club, go to <u>www.camconline.co.uk</u>. The C&A membership system is instant and a digital card will be issued straight away.
- 3. ENTRY FORM Please ensure that we have all the necessary details on your entry form. The name on the entry form must match the name on your competition licence. Names and contact details of Next of Kin are often overlooked.
- 4. MARSHALS Please remember that to make the event run smoothly it helps if you have booked your marshal location in advance send Dylan Jones, our chief marshal a TEXT on 07867520875 with the following information:
 - Marshal Name
 - Driver Name
 - Control type preference (Passage or Time)

Please assist the organisers by doing your best to comply with the above.

3. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Event No. Authorisation 28923JA20/21 has been issued. Motorsport UK Permit No. 133661 has been issued. Type of event – Rallying - Road Timed Status of event: Interclub

WAMC Championship no. – TBA ANWCC Championship no. - CH2024/Rally035

4. Eligibility

The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club and members of ANWCC and WAMC affiliated clubs.

All drivers will be required to declare that their vehicle is taxed and insured for the road and has a current MOT certificate.

All cars must comply with the Motorsport UK Tyre and Vehicle Regulations as written and specified within the 2024. Please take notice of R.18.6.3.

Motorsport UK Yearbook Your tyres must comply with the Motorsport UK 2024 Yearbook (See L.3) and carry a valid 'E' mark. It is compulsory that all competitors respect the regulations for Control of Drugs and Alcohol as contained in the General Regulations C1.1.7, D35.1, G15.1.4, H38

Every Crew <u>must</u> supply a Marshal; **No Marshal = No Start**

5. Programme

The start venue will be at the Main Hall, Ysgol Dyffryn Nantlle, Kings Rd, Penygroes, Caernarfon LL54 6RL.

The finish will be at Pant Du Vineyard, County Rd, Penygroes, Caernarfon LL54 6HE. **PLEASE** no trailers here as there is no space to turn around!!

Noise check and scrutineering will take place between 17:00 hours and 20:30 hours.

Any crew including their marshal not signed on by 21:00 hours may be refused a start and their place offered to a reserve crew. There will be no refund of entry fee.

Drivers briefing will be at 21:30 hours inside the main hall at Ysgol Dyffryn Nantlle. Cars will start at one-minute intervals and the time of issue of route information will be advised on the noticeboard.

Car 0 will start this event at approximately 00:00 hours and finish at 05:10 hours. Competing cars are required to carry enough fuel to cover approximately 75 miles. Total mileage will be approximately 118 miles.

PLEASE FOLLOW MARSHALS' DIRECTIONS

9 Insurance

Vehicles must have a valid motor insurance policy which provides as a minimum, Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act.

This can be either, by extending an existing motor policy to cover the event, or, by purchasing additional cover, providing under the Event Road Section Scheme as an adjunct to an existing motor policy.

If a competitor has an extension to their existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

If a competitor wishes to purchase additional Road Section cover via the organisers then they can do so prior to the event providing they comply with the following:

- is aged 19 years or over
- has held a full driving licence for a minimum of 6 months
- has no more than 6 points on their licence

• has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years is named on a valid motor insurance policy for the vehicle they are driving

- · do not have the Third-Party Extension cover on their existing motor policy
- the vehicle has a valid MOT and taxed for the road, unless exempt from doing so

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their codriver be a more senior member of their family or over 25.

Any competitor who falls outside these parameters may be offered cover at equivalent terms or an agreed price, if approval from the Appointed Insurance Broker has been obtained by the event organisers, prior to the event.

Approval can be sought by sending an email to contact@reis.co.uk and provide the Drivers' name and date of birth, the date they past their driving test and details of any motoring claims and/or convictions.

Additional cover provided by this scheme is only effective whilst the vehicle is actively competing in the event and remains under the control or direction of the event organiser(s).

Cover will cease immediately if you are precluded, excluded (disqualified) or retire from the event.

The Event Road Section scheme is provided by ABC Insurance Brokers Limited and underwritten by Slipstream Underwriting a trading style of First Underwriting Limited.

15 Penalties

Reminder:

Any competitors found to be utilising mobile phones to acquire route/control information that they otherwise would not possess will be Disqualified.

Any competitors found to be what the organisers deem to be practicing on any lanes during the time following up to the event **will be Disqualified at MCO. No refund of entry fee will be given.**

The organisers will not enter into **any** discussion regarding seeding. Any attempts by competitors to influence their seeding will be judged as breaches of C1.1.3.

Information

Trailer Park (see location plan)

- Trailer parking is at Penygroes Industrial Estate, Penygroes, Caernarfon, LL54 6DB. Please follow orange arrows and the marshals' instructions.
- Please park sensibly and **DO NOT** block entrances. Vehicles are left at owners' risk & C&A Motor Club cannot guarantee security of your property.
- Trailers are **not** to be loaded at Pant Du or Ysgol Dyffryn Nanttle following the event.

<u>Petrol</u>

- Please ensure that you have put fuel in your vehicle before you arrive at the start venue as you will not be allowed to leave once scrutineering, etc., have been completed.
- 'Super' / E5 Fuel in NOT available at the fuel halt
- Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 75 miles.

Noise Test (see location plan)

- Only the two crew members to go with the car to Noise Test.
- OPENS 17:00 hours / CLOSES PROMPTLY 20:30 hours.
- Pick up process card proceed to scrutineering, see below.

Scrutineering (see location plan)

- Only the two crew members to go with the car to scrutineering.
- OPENS 17:00 hours / CLOSES 20:30 hours.

After successfully passing scrutineering please make your way to Ysgol Dyffryn Nantlle (see diagram at the end), park your vehicle as directed by the marshal & proceed to the signingon area within the main hall building.

<u>Signing-on</u>

- You will have signed-on online.
- Only the two crew members to go into the allocated room to collect information.
- OPENS 17:30 hours / CLOSES 21:30 hours
- Competitors should present their process card from Noise Test and Scrutineering to collect their pack.
- Your marshal should have signed-on online (note: NO MARSHAL= NO START).
- Only the marshal to go into the allocated room to collect information.
- <u>A Map check will be conducted at the signing on hall and your maps will be stamped.</u> <u>You are not permitted to cut off the stamped area or stick/glue it anywhere else on</u> <u>the map. Further map checks along the route will be conducted to ensure</u> <u>compliance.</u>

If you wish to become a member of C&A motor club before the event you should apply at https://www.camconline.co.uk/become-amember

You will be supplied with two Rally Plates. Adhere one to the rear screen and the other to the nearside rear side window.

<u>Route</u>

- Standard sections will be run at an average speed of 30mph.
- The time recorded at all Time Controls will be when the competitor presents their time card to the marshal.
- You MUST adhere to quiets and Non-Competitive areas by switching off your spotlights and engaging the highest gear possible to minimise noise.
- You are reminded that all forward motion must cease at Give Way junctions on competitive sections.
- DSO's will be utilised to observe and record their findings at various points on the route.
- A <u>huge</u> amount of work and effort has been undertaken by the JJ Brown Memorial Road Rally team to secure the use of some PR sensitive areas. To enable us to maintain the future use of these areas we would ask that you adhere closely to the instructions in the route information regarding Quiets and Non-Competitive areas.

Marshals

Remember, the rule of '**NO MARSHAL = NO START**' will be strictly adhered to.

- Marshal signing-on **OPENS 18:00 hours** / **CLOSES 20:30 hours**.
- Your marshal is your responsibility; please ensure they have:
 - 1. Access to maps 115, 123 and 124 latest editions. (*A Map cutout will be given and should be ample to get you to your control)
 - 2. Suitable pens, clipboards and high visibility clothing, torch and a hammer to knock in control boards.
 - 3. Bin bag to take away their rubbish.

• Ensure your marshal understands where they are going and what they are doing. As stated in the SRs, all competing crews must provide a marshal(s) to cover at least one control and they MUST sign-on with **ONE** competing crew only.

- You are reminded that **no named official can be signed on as a marshal**.
- If the marshal who has signed on for a competitor does not turn up at a control or leaves the control area before the arrival of the closing car, or is reported for driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute, the associated competitor will be disqualified from the results.
- The Chief Marshal/Timekeeper will issue marshals who are allocated time controls with an official clock. The clock must be handed to the closing car or a club official once the control is closed.
- Should these clocks be damaged or go missing the competitor associated with that marshal will be held responsible for the cost of replacing or repairing that clock.

Controls

We aim to man all Passage Controls (PC) & Time Controls (TC), however, if for some reason a control is not manned, the organisers reserve the right to replace this with a Route Check (RC) in the form of a code board. Such boards will be on display at the start. If a board is present, crews must record the code in the appropriate box and it must be verified at the next manned control (excluding DSO's, Secret Checks).

General Information

- Competitors are reminded of the requirement of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act to report any incident involving injury to a third party to North Wales Police.
- The drivers briefing will be held at the signing-on area at approximately 21:30 hours.

<u>ALL</u> competitors must be present at the briefing and will be required to sign confirmation of attendance.
