FURTHER INFORMATION

COMPETITORS' PACKS & IDENTIFICATION

ON ARRIVAL AT THE VENUE, COMPETITORS MUST FIRST COLLECT THEIR RALLY PACK FROM RALLY OFFICE <u>BEFORE</u> GOING TO SCRUTINEERING.

The organisers will supply door number, hi-viz numbers for affixing to your rear side windows, and rear numbers. These will be in your rally pack, along with our sponsor's decals, which will be available from Rally Office (in the Circuit Tower ground floor) from 16:00hrs to 20.00 hours on Saturday, 14th June, and 06.30 hours to 08.00 hours on Sunday, 15th June.

Our sponsor's decals <u>MUST</u> be affixed one on each of your front door panels (except where bodywork restricts this, then they must be affixed one to either side of the car). No sponsor's decals are to be affixed to the front or rear bodywork of the car.

Cars must be presented for scrutineering with numbers and decals in place.

PROCESS CARDS

A process card will be issued at document collection and fully signed cards must be handed in at MC1 on Sunday morning.

Competitors are reminded to have their club cards and competition licences available for inspection on request at Competitor Pack collection.

TRACK SIGHTING

Competitors are reminded that they are permitted to walk/cycle the circuit as detailed in the SRs as follows:

- Track sighting by foot or pedal cycle is only permitted between 07:00hrs and 08:00hrs on Sunday morning only. <u>NO ACCESS TO THE TRACK WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SATURDAY</u> <u>EVENING</u>
- <u>All persons present on circuit during this period MUST wear hi-vis clothing.</u>

Setup teams and their vehicles will be present on track during the sighting period. Please comply with any requirement of the event officials on track and be vigilant of vehicles on track.

Queries will be accepted on forms available from the CLO in Rally Office – Ground floor of the Control Tower.

MISCELLANEOUS

Please also note the following:

- Cycling Will not be permitted in the service area.
- Accidents If a crew is involved in an accident both members MUST report to the Chief Medical Officer for examination immediately, if they intend to continue or not.
- Dogs are strictly not allowed within the venue.
