Final Instructions

First, an apology from us. It has been a number of years since we have run a championship car trial, so we were a little unfamiliar with the formalities of what Permits to apply for. We hope the amendments issued here are clear enough. If anyone is still not sure on any aspect, or you disagree with the amendments please contact Lee Matthews on 07778 905571 as soon as possible, and no later than 22.00 hours on Thursday, 6th July 2023, otherwise we will assume you all agree, and we will welcome you on Saturday.

Thank you for entry. If you have not entered yet but intend doing so, complete either online entry form Interclub or Clubman (we will amend) at <https://www.camconline.co.uk/events/2023-7-8/mas-car-trial> .

Signing-on will be between 08:00 hours and 09:30 hours.

Entries close at 09:30 hours.

Drivers briefing at 09:45 hours.

The first car will start at 10:00 hours.

The venue entrance is the same as Rhuddlan Bach Quarry, LL78 7JJ. The gravel road across the first field has been repaired, so now has good access. We have hired a port-a-loo for the event. We have not arranged any refreshments on this occasion, so please bring your own. **Please take your litter home with you.**

Once at the venue please first report to signing-on in the club office, then scrutineering. Please have your Competition Licences and Membership Cards ready for inspection. Once all processes are completed you may have a go at the practice hill as many times as you wish. This is located in the same field as the office. Access to the car trial field prior to 10am is permitted on foot only.

You are reminded that aggressive pattern tyres are NOT permitted. If in doubt send a photo to Lee.

Cars will be divided into groups, and each group will start at a different hill. Please run in numerical order, even when there are dual entries. Competition numbers will be on display on the notice board and at signing-on.

The nearest petrol station / shop / café is in Pentraeth.

If you need to contact the organisers on the day, or are running late getting there, contact Lee Matthews on 07778 905571.

Amendment to Supplementary Regulations.

- 3. PERMITS:-** The Interclub permit has been cancelled, and everyone will now run as one event under Clubman permit 131875.
- 4. ELIGIBILITY:-** Drivers and passengers will require a Motorsport UK Competition Licence of minimum grade RS Clubman (available free of charge).
- 5. CHAMPIONSHIPS:-** The event will form part of the BTRDA, ANWCC, C&A Motor Club and Glynne Edwards Memorial championships as listed in SRs.
- 6. PROGRAMME:-** All entries close at 09:30hours on 08/07/2023.
- 7. CLASSES:-** Classes will be as per the Interclub list in the Srs A - D, plus class Z for modified cars. Cars that had entered Class Y will now be placed into Class A or B.
- 10. TESTS:-** There will be 2 timed and 4 to 5 untimed sections per round. There will be 2 rounds before lunch and 2 after.
- 12. RESULTS:-** For event purposes, results and awards will be based on marks lost as per the Clubman SRs. However, for BTRDA and ANWCC points, results will be based on the usual Index of performance, including Class Z.
- 13. AWARDS:-** Add:- Highest placed lady driver will receive an award.
- 15. IDENTIFICATION:-** Competitors will be issued with competition numbers at signing-on.
