You do not have to do anything other than renew your registration and the appropriate grade will be automatically given to you.

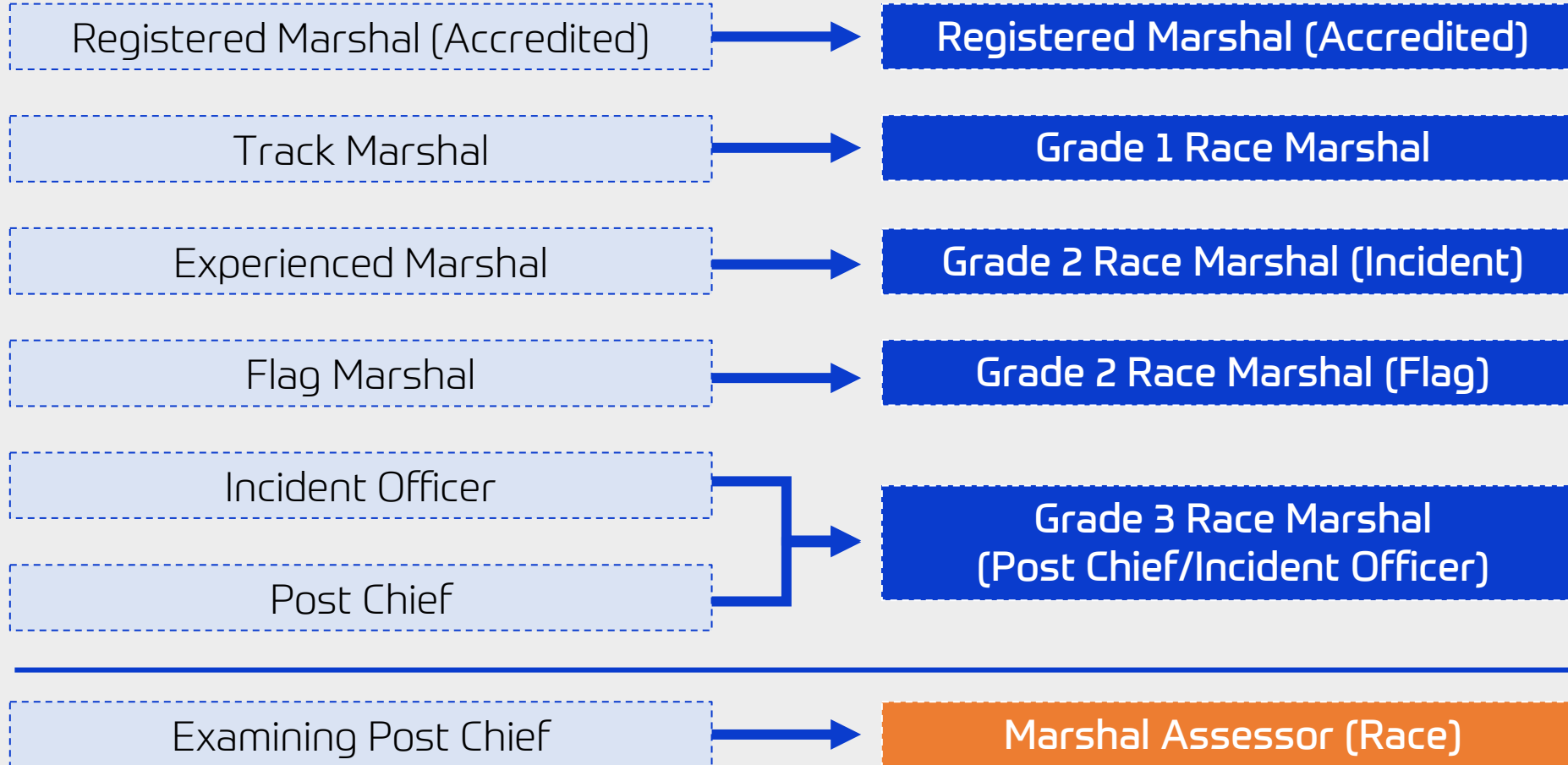

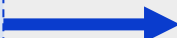
Grade 1 Off Track Marshal

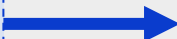

Event Official

The Event Official title remains in place to recognise those roles which fall outside of the Marshals' Pathway, and which are Club nominated, such as Service Area Manager, Chief Marshal and Event Secretary.

Those who currently hold more than one Rally Marshal grade (e.g., Radio and Timing) will receive both grades upon renewal. Those who hold Sector, Timing and Radio will receive a Grade 3 Rally Marshal registration.

Examining Stage Commanders will receive a Marshal Assessor grade upon completion of the Motorsport UK Assessor Course and will also receive a Stage Commander Marshals registration. Those who no longer wish to carry out assessments will be given a Stage Commander registration.
