Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry to the 2023 Lucas Oil Rali Menai Stages. The seeded entry list will be published on the dedicated Lucas Oil Rali Menai Stages page on the C&A Motor Club website, www.camconline.co.uk, no later than Wednesday 7th June at 19:00 hours.

The organisers will supply hi-viz numbers for affixing to your rear side windows. Door numbers will be available to purchase from the Rally Pack collection point in the tower ground floor office. Our sponsor's decals may be available at Environmental Scrutineering (Noise Test) on Sunday morning and must be affixed one on each of your front door panels.

ADDITIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE SR'S

5. Licences

Competitors must bring their competition licences, club membership cards and vehicle passports with them to the event. Random checks will be established to check all the aforementioned documents.

10. Classes

Delete Class E.

Class H will be amalgamated with the relevant capacity class.

11. Awards

An award will be presented to first three crews in each class with the exception of Class A where only first & second in class awards will be awarded.

Delete reference to Novice Award.

14. Scrutineering

Competitors are required to present their vehicle and their equipment along with the competition logbook/passport to scrutineering between the hours stated in the table above. Cars must be presented to scrutineering with door numbers in place. If an onboard camera is being used, the camera and its mount must be presented to scrutineering attached to the car as it will be for the stages.

Competitors will be required to show the scrutineers their overalls, helmet, and HANS device.

20 Roadbook / Timecards

A copy of the roadbook will be supplied to each competitor.

The event will be using the check sheet only system for recording stage times to minimise paper handling. Timecards will NOT be provided, there will be a place on the stage diagrams for competitors to record their times if they wish.

28. Judges of Fact

A full list of Judges of Fact will be published on the virtual noticeboard before the commencement of Stage 1.

PROCESS CARDS

A process card will be issued at scrutineering.

Once your car has passed scrutineering, take your process card to the Rally Office (located on the ground floor of the tower) to collect your Rally Pack.

Now keep your process card safe.

On Sunday morning present your car with your process card at Environmental Scrutineering.

Again, keep your process card safe, and hand it to the marshal at MC1.

- Accidents If a crew is involved in an accident both members MUST report to the Chief Medical Officer for examination immediately, if they intend to continue or not.
- Dogs are strictly not allowed within the venue.
