3 AUTHORISATION

Motorsport UK Permit No. 129182 has been issued.

7 CLASSES

The following definitions apply to either crew member in the role now entered (driver as driver / navigator as navigator) based on their previous performances at time of publication of these regulations (no matter how long ago) as follows:

Class 1 – MENTOR (Crews entered in this class will only be eligible for class awards).

The Mentor can be either a Master / Expert / Semi Expert Driver or Navigator, and the Mentee must be eligible to enter in Class 2 or 3 in the role now entered.

Class 2 - NOVICE

An individual, in the role now entered, who has won no more than two awards on a rally (excluding Beginner or Team awards).

Class 3 - BEGINNER

An individual, in the role now entered, has been classified as a finisher on a maximum of one Road Rally and has not won an award.

An individual is **<u>NOT</u> eligible to compete in Class 2 & 3**, in the role now entered, if they meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Has finished in the top ten on a National B (now Interclub from 1st January 2020) or higher status rally.
- Has finished in the top five in a Clubman status rally (excluding novice events).
- Has won more than two class awards.
- Has won any class award in a class higher than novice e.g., Master, Expert, Semi-Expert, or equivalent.

Historic, 12-Car or Targa Rally results will not count towards classification but may be used by organisers for seeding purposes as they deem appropriate.

If fewer than four cars are entered in any one class, this class may be amalgamated with the next appropriate class.

Both driver and navigator must declare their class separately on the entry form.

Where a crew is made up of persons from different classes, they must enter the higherranking class. For example: A Beginner driver may enter with a Novice navigator but must enter the Novice class. The organisers reserve the right to place crews in the appropriate class if it is considered that they have declared an incorrect class on the entry form.

The Valentine Trophy will be awarded to the first Beginner crew.

8 ENTRIES

Entries open 19:00 hours on Friday, 20th January 2023, and close finally at 23.59 hours on Sunday, 12th February 2023.
