AWARDS

Additional awards:

Under 21 Driver - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

Under 21 Navigator - Awarded to Navigator of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

1st Lady Driver - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car lady driver and not winning an overall or class award

1st Lady Navigator - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car lady navigator not winning an overall or class award.

Up to 1400 Capacity Cars: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity not winning an overall or class award.

Competitors will only be awarded 1 of the above awards unless no other eligible crew complete the event.

Fastest time on the Special Test – Awarded to driver and navigator of the fastest car on the special test

Best Presented Car

All other awards remain as listed in the Supplementary Regulations, with 1st, 2nd and 3rd awarded in each class.

SPECIAL TEST

If you experience a puncture on the special test PULL OVER immediately in a safe place. Crews may replace a wheel and complete the test. Penalty for failure to do so will be disqualification and incur cost of any damage to track surface.

OTHER

There is a bar at the start venue and any competing driver, navigator, or their marshal that is recorded consuming any drink containing alcohol will result in that crew not being allowed to start the event.

INSURANCE

For drivers taking advantage of the Bluefin Sport (previously Jelf) insurance scheme, the standard premium is £29 including tax.

For drivers who have a Letter of Acceptance, the premium is shown on the letter. If you do not comply with the eligibility criteria and do not have a Letter of Acceptance you will not be allowed to start the event and will forfeit your entry fee.

All other drivers are required to supply the name and address of the vehicle's insurers and Insurance Agent – MotorSport UK General Regulations D.12.3.6 and R.5.1.2

VEHICLES

As this is one of the 1st Road Rallies of 2023, please ensure that your car complies with the 2023 Motorsport UK Blue Book regulations.

Trailer Park

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map.

Fuel

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event.

Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 60miles.

There will be a petrol halt at halfway – **This will be at Shell Britannia Garage, Menai Bridge. VPower Petrol will be available. The shop will be open and hot food will be sold**.

Fuel is NOT available at Trac Môn.

Special Tests

Signed-on competitors will be permitted to walk the tests up to 19:00 hours, prior to the drivers' briefing. *Please wear a Hi-Vis – failure to do so may result in you not being able to start the event.*

Test Briefing

A drivers' 'briefing for the special test will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 19:10hours. A check will be done to ensure all competitors have attended.

Drivers' Briefing

A drivers' briefing will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 21:15hours. A check will be done to ensure all competitors have attended.

Test sighting run

Due to the status of the event being for Novice and Beginner crews, and on safety grounds the organisers will arrange a sighting run for the special test for all competitors prior to the first competitor attempting the special test. This will be in the form of a convoy behind a safety car. All competitors are welcome to walk the test prior to the event, however the must all be off the track by 19:00
