FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry to the Beespeed JJ Brown Memorial Road Rally 2021. Your entry number is as per the provisional entry list online at –

Please see the plan below for location of the trailer park, noise test and scrutineering.

A reminder that both members of your crew need to comply with certain important requirements.

1. SIGNING-ON - Online signing-on closes at **22.00 hours on Thursday, 2nd** December. You need to have uploaded a clear photo of your valid Motorsport UK competition licence and club membership card. If you have not received your competition licence from Motorsport UK, we will need sight of the acknowledgement of your application.
2. CLUB MEMBERSHIP - You must be a member of C&A Motor Club to be eligible to compete. If you need to apply for membership, go to www.camconline.co.uk. You may not receive your membership card before the event, but we will have a record of who has applied.
3. ENTRY FORM – Please ensure that we have all the necessary the details on your entry form. The name on the entry form must match the name on your competition licence. Names and contact details of Next of Kin are often overlooked. To check or update your entry form, go to <https://mtc1.uk/Entry/JJBrown21/EntryList.php>.
4. MARSHALS – Online signing-on for marshals closes at 22.00 hours on Saturday, 4th December, but it would be in everyone's interest to have this done as soon as possible. To book your marshal's place, please phone Dion Bee on 07562 095478.

Please assist the organisers by doing your best to comply with the above.

3. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Permit No. 123173 has been issued.

Type of event - Rally-Road Timed

Status of event: Clubmans.

Authorisation has been issued - Event No. CAO 28538DE4/5 applies.

4. Eligibility

All competitors must have a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman (or higher grade) competition licence and C&A Motor Club membership card. Copies of these should have been uploaded to the entries system but a random check may be carried out and you should have all relevant documents with you.

5. Programme

Delete reference to “Any crew (including their marshal) not signed on by 21:00 hours”.

Online signing-on closes at **22.00 hours on Thursday**, 2nd December. Marshal signing on closes at 22.00 hours on Saturday, 4th December.

The Noise Test will be at Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL55 2BD; O.S. Map 115; Reference 496½ 624¼.

Scrutineering will be located at Beespeed, Unit 1G, Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL55 2BD; O.S. Map 115; Reference 494¾ 626¾.

Trailer parking is available at Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL55 2BD - O.S. Map 115; Reference 496½ 627½ (park your trailer at own risk).

9 Insurance

For drivers taking advantage of the Bluefin Sport insurance scheme, the standard premium is £25.00, including tax, and will have been paid with your entry fee. For drivers who have a Letter of Acceptance, the premium is shown on the letter and we will need to see this at signing-on.

15 Penalties

Reminder:

Any competitors found to be utilising mobile phones to acquire route/control information that they otherwise would not possess will be Disqualified.

The organisers will not enter into any discussion regarding seeding. Any attempts by competitors to influence their seeding will be judged as breaches of C1.1.3.

Information

Covid Rules

You are reminded that a face covering, or mask must be worn inside the scrutineering venue and rally headquarters (Plas Menai) unless seated in the cafeteria. Please follow any designated one-way system.

Access to the rooms for collecting competitor packs and marshal packs is strictly limited to competitors and marshals respectively. Social distancing should be maintained as much as possible.

It is good practice to bring your own pen to the start venue in order to minimise cross contamination should you need to sign any paperwork.

Parking

Parking at the start venue is strictly limited to officials and competing cars. There is no parking for spectators, or navigators who arrive in separate vehicles.

The Basic Roamer Company

Petrol

- Please ensure that you have put fuel in your vehicle before you arrive at the start venue as you will not be allowed to leave once scrutineering, etc., have been completed.
- Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 60 miles. 'Super' unleaded/E5 petrol is available at the fuel halt.

Trailer Park (see location plan)

- Trailer parking is at Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL552BD: Map Ref 115/496¹/₂ 627¹/₂. Please follow the marshals' instructions.
- Please park sensibly and **DO NOT** block the entrance. Vehicles are left at owners' risk & C&A Motor Club cannot guarantee security of your property.
- Trailers are not to be loaded at Plas Menai following the event.

Noise Test (see location plan)

- Only the two crew members to go with the car to Noise Test.
- Map Ref 115/496¹/₂ 624¹/₄.
- **OPENS – 18:00 hours / CLOSSES PROMPTLY – 20:30 hours.**
- Pick up process card – proceed to scrutineering, see below.

Scrutineering (see location plan)

- Only the two crew members to go with the car to scrutineering.
- Beespeed, Unit 1G, Cibyn Industrial Estate: Map Ref 115/494³/₄ 626³/₄.
- **OPENS – 18:00 hours / CLOSSES – 20:30 hours.**

After successfully passing scrutineering please make your way to Plas Menai (115/503 659), park your vehicle as directed by the marshal & proceed to the signing-on area within the main building. Please note that the access to Plas Menai off the roundabout on the A487 is not as map. Depart NW at 115/506 658¹/₂

Signing-on

- You will have signed-on online.
- Only the two crew members to go into the allocated room to collect information.
- **OPENS – 18:30 hours / CLOSSES – 21:30 hours**
- Competitors should present their process card from Noise Test and Scrutineering to collect their pack.
- Your marshal should have signed-on online (note: **NO MARSHAL= NO START**).
- Only the marshal to go into the allocated room to collect information.

Please be reminded that all competitors must hold a current C&A Motor Club membership card and minimum grade RS Clubman competition licence. If you do not have current club membership you should apply before the event at <https://www.camconline.co.uk/become-a-member>

You will be supplied with two Rally Plates. Adhere one to the rear screen and the other to the nearside rear side window.

Route

- Standard sections will be run at an average speed of 30mph.
- Novice class competitors will collect the Route Information from MC0 at 23:00 hours plus you start number in minutes. Your route information will be a printed map, which will have all the details required to traverse the route.
- All other competitors will collect the Route Information from MC1 at 23:50 hours plus you start number in minutes. Your route information will be a printed map, which will have all the details required to traverse the route.
- Your start time at MC1 is 23.50 hours plus your start number in minutes
- The time recorded at all Time Controls will be when the competitor presents their time card to the marshal.
- You **MUST** adhere to quiet and Non-Competitive areas by switching off your spotlights and engaging the highest gear possible to minimise noise.
- You are reminded that all forward motion must cease at Give Way junctions on competitive sections.

- DSO's will be utilised to observe and record their findings at various points on the route.
- **A huge amount of work and effort has been undertaken by the Beespeed J.J. Brown Memorial Rally team to secure the use of some PR sensitive areas. To enable us to maintain the future use of these areas we would ask that you adhere closely to the instructions in the route information regarding Quiets and Non-Competitive areas.**

Marshals

Remember, the rule of '**NO MARSHAL = NO START**' will be strictly adhered to.

- Marshal signing-on **OPENS 18:15hours / CLOSSES 21.00 hours.**
- Your marshal is your responsibility; please ensure they have:
 1. **Map 115 latest edition.**
 2. **Suitable pens, clipboards and high visibility clothing, torch and a hammer to knock in control boards.**
 3. **Bin bag to take away their rubbish.**
- Ensure your marshal understands where they are going and what they are doing.

As stated in the SRs, all competing crews must provide a marshal(s) to cover at least one control and they **MUST** sign-on with **ONE** competing crew only.

- You are reminded that **no named official can be signed on as a marshal.**
- If the marshal who has signed on for a competitor does not turn up at a control or leaves the control area before the arrival of the closing car, or is reported for driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute, the associated competitor will be excluded from the results.
- The Chief Marshal/Timekeeper will issue marshals who are allocated time controls with an official clock. The clock must be handed to the closing car or a club official once the control is closed.
- Should these clocks be damaged or go missing the competitor associated with that marshal will be held responsible for the cost of replacing or repairing that clock.

Controls

We aim to man all Passage Controls (PC) & Time Controls (TC), however, if for some reason a control is not manned, the organisers reserve the right to replace this with a Route Check (RC) in the form of a code board. Such boards will be on display at the start. If a board is present, crews must record the code in the appropriate box and it must be verified at the next manned control (excluding DSO's, Secret Checks).

General Information

- Competitors are reminded of the requirement of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act to report any incident involving injury to a third party to North Wales Police.
- The drivers briefing will be held at the signing-on area at approximately 21:30 hours.

ALL competitors must be present at the briefing and will be required to sign confirmation of attendance.

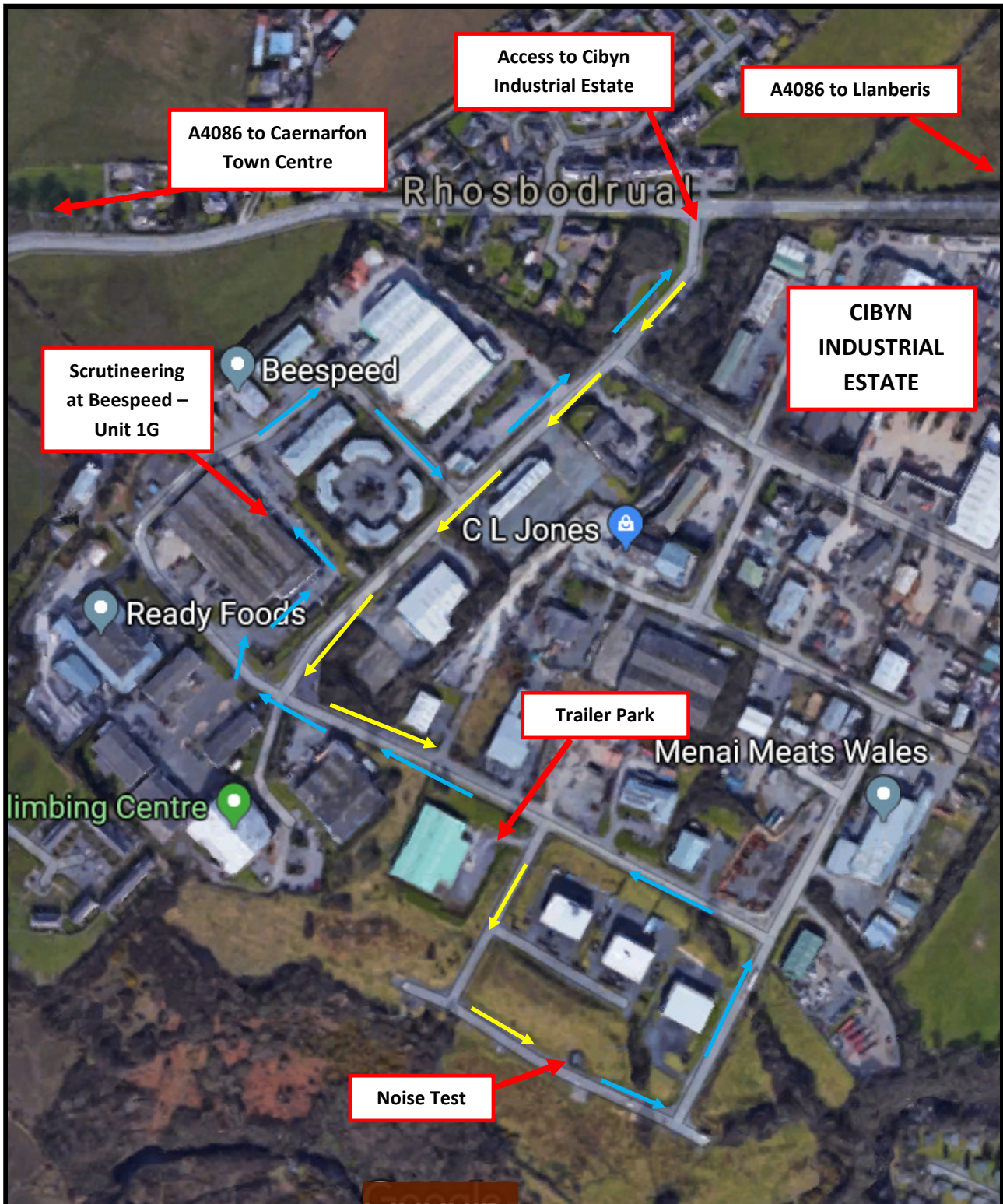
