AMENDMENTS TO THE SR'S

5. Licences

Competitors must bring their competition licences, club membership cards and vehicle passports/competition logbook with them to the event. Random checks will be established to check all of the aforementioned documents

6. Timetable

Delete all timetable items and replace with the above

11. Awards

An award will be presented to all top three crews in each class, with the exception of class E

1st overall Junior competitor will be awarded the Christopher Brierley Memorial Trophy in memory of Christopher Brierley; a member of C&A Motor Club for many years and a frequent co-driver for

junior competitors.

20. Roadbook / timecards

A copy of the roadbook will be supplied to each competitor.

14. Scrutineering

Competitors are required to present their vehicle and their equipment along with the competition logbook/passport to scrutineering between the hours stated in the table above. Any detachable lighting system (lamp pods etc.) which will be used on Saturday night must be fixed to the car and be in working order. If an onboard camera is being used, the camera and it's mount must be presented to scrutineering attached to the car as it will be for the stages.

Competitors will be required to show the scrutineers their overalls, helmet and HANS device. Minimal contact of competitors equipment by anyone other than the crew to be maintained.

High visibility numbers will be supplied by the organisers and must be affixed to the rear side windows on both sides of the vehicle. The event sponsors decal must also be affixed above the door numbers on both sides. Decals and high visibility numbers can be collected from the Rally Office on the ground floor of the tower building. Rally Marketing will be present on Saturday morning and will be selling door numbers. Please ensure that all event sponsor decals, door numbers and high visibility numbers are in their correct position before stage one commences.

29. Controls

Delete passage controls (PC). We will not be using a Passage Control on this event for the purpose of collecting time cards and issuing service time.

STAGE PROCEDURE FOR JUNIOR RALLY - REMINDER

This year's Glyn Memorial Stages is also a round of the Junior F1000 Rally Championship & Scottish Juniors 2019, as defined by the championship rules. As part of the Motorsport UK requirements/regulations for this championship, competitors in the championship must run on stages by themselves, i.e. there must not be any of the competitors from the main events on the stage at the same time as the Juniors. To achieve this there will be a gap between the main event and the Juniors which will therefore stretch the running of all the days stages to the limit. In order to achieve this, cars in the Junior event will be interposed from the first running of the stage straight back into the second running of the stage, and road timing between stages will be operating. Just as road timing will be operating in the main event.

Saturday

Main event will run first on the road.

As soon as all cars from the main event have completed the pair of stages, or maximum lateness of the last car in the main event has been reached, the Junior Rally will be started. At that point no cars from the main event will be allowed to move on the stage until the Juniors have finished their 2 runs through. If a car has stopped on stage for any reason and the Juniors have started, THEY MUST NOT MOVE UNTIL THE JUNIORS HAVE FINISHED THEIR 2 RUNS THROUGH THE STAGE. (Junior runners will be denoted by running numbers 101 upwards). **Penalty is disgualification**.

After the Juniors have finished, any outstanding cars from the main field must not return to the

paddock until permission has been granted via a radio marshal.

Sunday

Juniors will run first on the road.

As soon as all cars from the Junior event have completed the pair of stages, or maximum lateness of the last car in the Junior event has been reached, the Main Rally will be started. At that point no cars from the Junior event will be allowed to move on the stage until all cars in the main event have finished their 2 runs through. If a car has stopped on stage for any reason and the main event has started, THEY MUST NOT MOVE UNTIL THE MAIN EVENT COMPETITORS HAVE FINISHED THEIR 2 RUNS THROUGH THE STAGE. **Penalty is disqualification.**

After the main field have finished, any outstanding cars from the Juniors must not return to the paddock until permission has been granted via a radio marshal.

SUBMITTING A TIME QUERY

Time queries will not be accepted on paper this year. Time queries may be submitted in any of the following ways:-

- By writing your time query on paper, photographing it and sending the photograph via either a text message or a Whatsapp message to our Competition Liaison Officer (CLO), Peredur Davies on 07748 081300.

Replies to your time queries will be sent to you via text message or email.

In exceptional circumstances, you attendance may be required at the Rally Office. A face mask is compulsory within the Rally Office.

OTHER MATTERS

Please also note the following:-

- Road Rally Class Tyres as per Blue Book.
- Auxiliary lights Any auxiliary lights (Light bar, lamp pod etc.) fitted to the car must dip as the main headlights are dipped. The same switch must control the auxiliary lights on/off function as the dip/main beam of the car. This will be checked at scrutineering and will again be checked before the cars are allowed in to the night stages.

- Walking and cycling of the circuit Walking or cycling the circuit is permitted between 07:30hrs and 10:00hrs on Saturday morning only. However, a high visibility jacket MUST be worn at all times when either walking or cycling the circuit. Cycling in the paddock area is prohibited.
- Lights and reflective jackets for service crew The majority of day 1 will be held in the dark. Please give due consideration to the Health and Safety of your service crew. We strongly advise that you bring good quality torches or lights with you to aid your crew and that they wear high visibility clothing for the duration of the night stages.
- Food at the venue on Saturday night The circuit's bar will serve food up until 21:00hrs on Saturday night and will be serving a basic menu. There is no service time given at the end of day one therefore can you please make your way as soon as possible after the end of the last stage on Saturday to the bar if you require food.
- Accidents If a crew are involved in an accident both members MUST report to the Chief Medical Officer for examination Immediately, if they intend to continue or Not.
- Dogs are strictly not allowed within the venue
