These Final Instructions contain important information that updates or supersede the Supplementary Regulations, or act as reminders. Importantly, note the changes to the timetable and the clarification of the classes, awards and tyre regulations

CLARIFICATIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The event is named the Cefni Garage Trac Môn Targa.

5. CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2021 ANWCC Targa Rally Championship has been cancelled; championship regulation 1.17 applies. The event still qualifies for the ANWCC Allrounders, Ladies and Inter-Club Championships

6. PROGRAMME

Noise Check and Scrutineering will take place **between 06:00 hours and 08:30 hours**.

Any competitor not completed the 'drive thru' Competitor Pack collection by **08:45 hours** may be refused a start and their place offered to a reserve crew. If your marshal fails to sign on, you may be asked to return your pack prior to MC0 and will not be able to start the Targa.

There will be a drivers' briefing at **08:55 hours** (outside the Control Tower) and all competitors **MUST** attend.

Car 0 will start at MC0 at **09:30 hours** (for individual start times please add your car number to this time).

Car 0 is due at the finish at approximately **15:30 hours**.

7. CLASSES

Clarification – Competitors entered in Class 1, 2 or 3 MUST hold a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence of Interclub status.

Class 4 is for Clubman competitors who are paid-up members of C&A Motor Club and have a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman Competition Licence. See –

10. SCRUTINEERING

Wheel and Tyres – As per Motorsport UK General Regulations.

Following the Motorsport UK authorisation process for the event, we have been advised that the event runs under road rally regulations, therefore please note the following:

A. Please note that the North Wales Police and North Wales RLO requirement is for all competing cars to be fitted with tyres that carry a valid “E” mark.

B. Tyres must comply with current Motorsport UK Yearbook (Blue Book) specifications as follows:

3.2. For all Road, Navigation, Targa Road and Historic Road Rallies tyres are free subject to the following;

(a) Tyres on the current FIA List of Asphalt Eligible Tyres are permitted; including sizes not homologated;

(b) Tyres on List 1B (from 2020) and List 1C are not permitted other than the Avon CR28, the Avon CR6ZZ and the Pirelli P7 Corsa Classic, for pre 1/10/90 registered cars, the Yokohama A021R (manufactured before 01/11/14), and the Yokohama Advan A052;

(c) Tyres marked for "competition use" are not permitted with the exception of tyres on List 6 and 3.2a.

C. A maximum of six wheels/tyres are allowed per competing car; four fitted to the car and a maximum of two spares securely fitted in or on the car. All vehicles must carry a minimum of one spare wheel. Any vehicle that experiences a puncture must pull over in a safe place and replace the wheel before completing any test.

23. AWARDS

Due to limited numbers in Class 2 and Class 3, these classes will now be amalgamated as a Semi-Expert Class.

As a result of the high number of entrants in Class 4, we are keen to fairly allocate the awards. The Awards will now be as follows:

Awards will be presented at the finish venue once results are declared final.

1st, 2nd & 3rd Overall : Awards to driver and navigator.

1st & 2nd Expert: Awards to driver and navigator.

1st & 2nd Semi-Expert: Awards to driver and navigator.

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th Clubman: Awards to driver and navigator

Best 1400 c.c.: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity.

Best Family Crew: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed Family Crew. For the purpose of this event, a Family Crew is defined as a crew of parent and child; or siblings; or long-term partners.

Competitors will only be awarded 1 of the above awards, unless no other eligible crew complete the event.

Spirit of the Rally: Awarded at the discretion of the organising team.

Most Entertaining Driver: Awarded to Driver at the discretion of the Organising Team

Class Clai Charity Trophy: A one-off charity trophy has been donated by Dion Bee to raise money for the DPJ Foundation and Wales Air Ambulance. Signing on for the fun 'Class Clai Charity Trophy' will be available at the start venue / scrutineering bay. We are suggesting a donation of £10 per car with all the money being split 50/50 between the DPJ Foundation and The Wales Air Ambulance charities. The highest placed entrant to the 'Class Clai' that has not won any other award will win the charity trophy.

ARRIVAL, SCRUTINEERING & SIGNING-ON

Driving Standards / Road Traffic Act

Please remember to drive safely and with respect for residents, Circuit staff, marshals and spectators.

Overnight Camping

Overnight camping is available at Trac Môn/Anglesey Circuit, please do not pitch your caravan in the designated trailer parking or competitors' holding area. Electricity hook up is available and the café will be open for a period during Saturday evening.

Trailer Park

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map. Please note that this area is denoted as a prohibited area for competitors for the duration of the event once Car 1 has left MC0. Any competitor entering this area during the event will be deemed as retired.

Fuel

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event, refuelling during the event is not permitted.

Fuel is NOT available at Trac Môn.

Illegal Servicing

See Supplementary Regulation 19 - Servicing will not be permitted at any time during the event, except by crews working on their own vehicles, or by fellow competitors. The penalty for infringement is disqualification. All competing vehicle will be parked in the designated holding area between test turnarounds (see plan on page 6); this area will be deemed a Control Area.

Marshals' Signing-on

Signing-on will be in the garage nearest to the Tower Building.

Competitors' Signing-on

Competitors signing on will need to be done electronically prior to the event. Handing out of competitor packs will be a 'drive thru' process following completion of process card.

Special Tests

Signed-on competitors will be permitted to walk the tests up to 08:45 hours, prior to the drivers' briefing.

Drivers' Briefing

A drivers' briefing will be held outside the Tower Building at 08:55 hours and all competitors MUST attend this briefing.
