STAGE PROCEDURE FOR JUNIOR RALLY - REMINDER

This year's Glyn Memorial Stages is also a round of the Junior F1000 Rally Championship & Scottish Juniors 2019, as defined by the championship rules. As part of the Motorsport UK requirements/regulations for this championship, competitors in the championship must run on stages by themselves, i.e. there must not be any of the competitors from the main events on the stage at the same time as the Juniors. To achieve this there will be a gap between the main event and the Juniors which will therefore stretch the running of all the days stages to the limit. In order to achieve this, cars in the Junior event will be interposed from the first running of the stage straight back into the second running of the stage, and road timing between stages will be operating. Just as road timing will be operating in the main event.

Saturday

Main event will run first on the road.

As soon as all cars from the main event have completed the pair of stages, or maximum lateness of the last car in the main event has been reached, the Junior Rally will be started.

At that point no cars from the main event will be allowed to move on the stage until the Juniors have finished their 2 runs through. If a car has stopped on stage for any reason and the Juniors have started **THEY MUST NOT MOVE UNTIL THE JUNIORS HAVE FINISHED THEIR 2 RUNS THROUGH THE STAGE.** (Junior runners will be denoted by running numbers 101 upwards).

Penalty is exclusion.

After the Juniors have finished, any outstanding cars from the main field must not return to the paddock until permission has been granted via a radio marshal.

Sunday

Juniors will run first on the road.

As soon as all cars from the Junior event have completed the pair of stages, or maximum lateness of the last car in the Junior event has been reached, the Main Rally will be started.

At that point no cars from the Junior event will be allowed to move on the stage until all cars in the main event have finished their 2 runs through. If a car has stopped on stage for any reason and the main event has started **THEY MUST NOT MOVE UNTIL THE MAIN EVENT COMPETITORS HAVE FINISHED THEIR 2 RUNS THROUGH THE STAGE. Penalty is exclusion.**

After the main field have finished, any outstanding cars from the Juniors must not return to the paddock until permission has been granted via a radio marshal.

Other matters

Please also note the following:-

- **Scrutineering** – Cars must be presented for scrutineering with all lights, including spots, with correct dipped beam function. These, along with brake lights, will also be checked before the night stages after Stage 4.
- **Road Rally Class** – Tyres as per Blue Book.
- **Arrival Controls** – The area between the arrival control and the stage start is Parc Ferme. Once you have received your time at the arrival, no work can be carried out on the car except those listed in section H207. Outside assistance in this area is forbidden and only tools carried in the car can be used.
- **Competitors briefing** – It is mandatory that both members of each crew attend the Competitors briefing. Checks will be established to prove compliance.
- **Lights and reflective jackets for service crew** – The majority of day 1 will be held in the dark. Please give due consideration to the Health and Safety of your service crew. We strongly advise that you bring good quality torches or lights with you to aid your crew and that they wear high visibility clothing for the duration of the night stages.
- **Food at the venue on Saturday night** – The circuit's bar will be open on Saturday night from 19:30 until around 21:00.
- **Number stickers** – Competitors should ensure number stickers are on the car when presented at scrutineering. Hi-Vis numbers will be supplied by the organisers.
- **Rally Marketing** – Will be attending the event on Saturday.
- **Cycling** – Will not be permitted in the service area. If you wish to cycle the track, this is permitted before 10am on Saturday only.
- **Accidents** – If a crew are involved in an accident both members MUST report to the Chief Medical Officer for examination immediately, if they intend to continue or not.
