Any competitor not signed on by 20:30 hours (including their marshal) may be refused a start and their place offered to a reserve crew.

ENTRIES

It is confirmed that priority has been given to Novice and Beginner crews and there are no crews competing in the Expert class on this event.

OFFICIALS

Driving Standards Observers: List of named Driving Standards Observers will be posted on the notice board at signing on.

AWARDS

Additional awards:

Fastest time on the Special Test – Awarded to driver and navigator of the fastest car on the special test

Under 21 Driver - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

Under 21 Navigator - Awarded to Navigator of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

Up to 1400 Capacity Cars: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity not winning an overall or class award.

Best Family Crew: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed Family Crew not winning an overall or class award. For the purpose of this event, a Family Crew is defined as a crew of parent and child; or siblings; or long-term partners.

Spirt of the Rally Awards – These awards can be presented to any two individuals, at the discretion of the organising team

Best Presented Car: Award sponsored by Beespeed.

All other awards remain as listed in the Supplementary Regulations.

PENALTIES

Special Test

m. The wrong test penalty will be applied if you make an error on a test and pass the wrong side of a cone or go the wrong way around a cone.

- p. 4 Wheels on the grass Test Maximum
- q. If you experience a puncture on the special test PULL OVER immediately in a safe place, crews may replace a wheel and compete the test, Penalty for failure to do so will be disqualification, and incur cost of any damage to track surface

Other

There is a bar at the start venue and any competing driver, navigator, or their marshal, is recorded consuming any drink containing alcohol, will result in that crew will not be allowed to start the event.

INSURANCE

For drivers taking advantage of the Jelf insurance scheme, the standard premium is £20, including tax.

For drivers who have a Letter of Acceptance, the premium is shown on the letter. If you do not comply with the eligibility criteria and do not have a Letter of Acceptance you will not be allowed to start the event and will forfeit your entry fee.

All other drivers are required to supply the name and address of the vehicle's insurers and Insurance Agent - MSA General Regulations D.12.3.6 and R.5.1.2

VEHICLES

As this is one of the 1st Road Rallies of 2020, please ensure that your car complies with the 2020 MotorSport UK Blue Book regulations.

Following a number of enquiries regarding the fitting of VERTICAL hydraulic handbrakes in a road rally car, please note, they are prohibited, as per regulation R18.6.3 (Road Rally Misc). To avoid disappointment, please check that your car meets the 2020 regulations.

LICENCES

As this is one of the 1st Road Rallies of 2020, and under the new MotorSport UK licencing structure, you will require a minimum of an RS Clubman licence, which is free of charge at the link below

Trailer Park

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map.

Fuel

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event, Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 70 miles. There will be no provision for petrol during the event. Fuel is NOT available at Trac Môn.

Competitors' Signing-on

Special Tests

Signed-on competitors will be permitted to walk the tests up to 20:30 hours, prior to the drivers' briefing.

Drivers' Briefing

A drivers' briefing will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 20:45 hours and all competitors MUST sign to confirm they have attend this briefing.

Test sighting run

Due to the status of the event being for Novice and Beginner crews, and on safety grounds the organisers will arrange a sighting run for the special test for all competitors prior to the first competitor attempting the special test. This will be in the form of a convoy behind a safety car. All competitors are welcome to walk the test prior to the event, however the must all be off the track by 20:30
