We have worked hard to provide you with a no nonsense straight forward event based on the lanes of Anglesey on Map114. A huge amount of work and effort has been undertaken by the team to secure the use of some PR sensitive areas. To enable us to maintain the future use of these areas we would ask that you adhere closely to instructions in the route information regarding Quiet Zones and Non-Competitive sections.

Please arrive early to enable a smooth Competitor Pack Collection. Please note the rule below regarding the consumption of alcoholic drink by crews and their marshal at the start venue.

ENTRIES

It is confirmed that priority has been given to Novice and Beginner crews and there are no crews competing in the Expert class on this event.

Seeded Entry List

Will be sent with the Final Instructions providing ALL competitors have uploaded all the relevant documentation and signed on via their entry form. If this has not been done, Seeded Entry List will be delayed until all formalities have been completed by competitors.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the finish venue once results are declared final. The named trophies and cups remain the property of Caernarvonshire & Anglesey Motor Club Limited and must be returned within one year or upon request, whichever is earlier.

1st Beginner crew The Valentine Trophy & awards to driver and navigator.
1st Overall crew The Mick Lindley Memorial Trophy & awards to driver and navigator.
1st in each class (subject to 4 entries) Awards to driver and navigator.
2nd in each class (subject to 6 entries) Awards to driver and navigator.
3rd in each class (subject to 8 entries) Awards to driver and navigator.

Additional awards:

Under 21 Driver - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

Under 21 Navigator - Awarded to Navigator of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

Up to 1400 Capacity Cars: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity not winning an overall or class award.

Competitors will only be awarded 1 of the above awards unless no other eligible crew complete the event.

Fastest time on the Special Test – Awarded to driver and navigator of the fastest car on the special test

Best Presented Car: Award sponsored by Llechan Llyn.

PENALTIES

Special Test

Penalties on Special Tests: 1st = 1st offence / 2nd = 2nd offence

- Taking the Bogey Time or less than the Bogey Time: Bogey Time
- Taking longer than the Bogey Time but less than the Maximum Time: Actual Time Taken
- Taking longer than the Maximum Time, or failing to complete a test: Test Maximum

- d. Not attempting a test:Test Maximum + 5mins
- e. Driving wrong side of a single cone or marker:1st +30 seconds / 2nd Test Maximum
- f. Striking a cone or marker: +10 seconds per cone/marker
- g. Failing to stop at a finish line (actual attempt made to stop):Test Maximum
- h. Jump Start on a Test: +30 seconds
- i. Not completing a test by the correct route other than in 'n' or 'r': Test Maximum
- j. Starting, but not completing a test: Test Maximum
- k. Not providing proof of visiting a Passage Control: +30 seconds per offence
- l. Not recording the correct code from a code board (if used): +30 seconds per offence
- m. The wrong test penalty will be applied if you make an error on a test and pass the wrong side of a cone or go the wrong way around a cone.
- n. Striking a barrier: +30 seconds per offence
- o. 2 Wheels on the grass +30 seconds per offence
- p. 4 Wheels on the grass Test Maximum
- q. If you experience a puncture on the special test PULL OVER immediately in a safe place, crews may replace a wheel and compete the test, Penalty for failure to do so will be disqualification, and incur cost of any damage to track surface

OTHER

There is a bar at the start venue and any competing driver, navigator, or their marshal, is recorded consuming any drink containing alcohol, will result in that crew will not be allowed to start the event.

INSURANCE

For drivers taking advantage of the Bluefin Sport (previously Jelf) insurance scheme, the standard premium is £20, including tax.

For drivers who have a Letter of Acceptance, the premium is shown on the letter. If you do not comply with the eligibility criteria and do not have a Letter of Acceptance you will not be allowed to start the event and will forfeit your entry fee.

All other drivers are required to supply the name and address of the vehicle's insurers and Insurance Agent – Motorsport UK General Regulations D.12.3.6 and R.5.1.2

VEHICLES

As this is one of the 1st Road Rallies of 2022, please ensure that your car complies with the 2022 Motorsport UK Blue Book regulations.

Trailer Park

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map.

Fuel

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event.

Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 75 miles.

There will be no provision for petrol during the event.

Fuel is **NOT** available at Trac Môn.

Competitors' Pack Collection

Special Tests

Following Pack Collection, competitors will be permitted to walk the tests up to 20:30 hours, prior to the drivers' briefing. **Please wear a Hi-Vis – failure to do so may result in you not being able to start the event.**

Drivers' Briefing

A drivers' briefing will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 20:45 hours. A check will be done to ensure all competitors have attended.

Test sighting run

Due to the status of the event being for Novice and Beginner crews, and on safety grounds the organisers will arrange a sighting run for the special test for all competitors prior to the first competitor attempting the special test. This will be in the form of a convoy behind a safety car. All competitors are welcome to walk the test prior to the event, however they must all be off the track by 20:30
